# C-Cube organises Inaugural Meeting of the ClimateSmart Cities Alliance

The Climate Centre for Cities (C-Cube) organised the Inaugural Meeting of the ClimateSmart Cities Alliance on Wednesday, 14 October, 2020 to kick-off the Alliance activities and chart out potential opportunities & collaborations going forward. The virtual meeting was attended by 87 participants from 50 organisations including Multi-laterals/ Bi-lateral Organisations, Research and Training Institutes, (I)NGOs, Network Organisations, Philanthropies, Foundations, Development Banks, Solution Providers, Incubators, Industry Partners and Rating Agencies.

Speaking at the occasion, Sh. Kunal Kumar, Joint Secretary and Mission Director (Smart Cities), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) stated, "The next few years will be extremely critical for us, with respect to urban development in India, and the climate change and sustainable development discourse globally. Through the ClimateSmart Alliance, together, we can play a key role in driving India's response and action in this limited window of opportunity. As the Secretariat of the Alliance, C-Cube will act as a market place, a one stop shop to help you connect with cities and other stakeholders to jointly take forward these initiatives."

Sh. Hitesh Vaidya, Director, NIUA said, "We envision the Alliance to act as a driving force for building urban climate action in India and intend to scale up our efforts to reach the 4000+ ULBs in the country. To that end, we propose to pool in our efforts and resources with the Alliance partners for mobilising collaborative action - towards capacity building, implementation of pilots and projects, making the available knowledge easily accessible to cities and urban practitioners".

As the Secretariat of the ClimateSmart Cities Alliance instituted by the MoHUA, Govt. of India; C-Cube is engaging with a range of stakeholders towards building cohesive urban climate action in India. C-Cube is also in the process of developing a Data Wall and Alliance Dashboard to facilitate knowledge engagement.
