


CLIMATESMART CITIES ASSESSMENT FRAMEWORK BUILDS THE URBAN CLIMATE ACTION MOVEMENT IN INDIA

The Climate Smart Cities Assessment Framework is getting into its last week of data collection with the deadline being 13 November 2020. To support the cities, Climate Centre for Cities has increased its focus on developing partnerships between cities with supporting organisations for on-ground help as well as conducting multiple daily online training sessions through the week. This has been done to facilitate and maximise the data filling process at the city.

This week, C-Cube conducted 8 online mentoring sessions to support all the cities and supporting partner coordinators who joined the assessment in October. The workshop focused on illustrating indicator wise data points and evidence templates required for the assessment. Step-by-step navigation of the portal for filling out data points was also demonstrated. More than 100 city nodal officers and supporting partner coordinators joined the workshops. In addition, 4 orientation workshops for new supporting partners was also conducted. As we move to the last week of the assessment, dedicated and special trainings based on the need and request from cities will be facilitated.


This week, 82 cities crossed the 80% mark and 109 cities have reached the 50% mark on the data portal.
