CLIMATESMART CITIES ASSESSMENT FRAMEWORK 2.0 LAUNCHED

Shri Hardeep Singh Puri, Minister of State for Housing and Urban Affairs (I/C), Government of India launched the 'ClimateSmart Cities Assessment Framework' (CSCAF) 2.0 and 'Streets for People' initiatives under the Smart Cities Mission in a virtual event on September 11, 2020. CSCAF 2.0 is the revamped version of the first of its kind framework, which was developed and launched by MoHUA in 2019.

The framework has 28 indicators across five themes and intends to provide a roadmap for cities to combat climate change and implement necessary actions. To that end, CSCAF evaluation will be conducted as an annual activity starting 2020 and is intended to cover 500+ cities in the next five years.

139 cities including all Smart Cities, State Capitals and other cities with more than five lakh population will be participating in this phase of assessment that will be undertaken over a span of 3 months. The Climate Centre for Cities (C-Cube) will function as the national support unit for all activities to be implemented under the CSCAF and handhold cities through the process.
