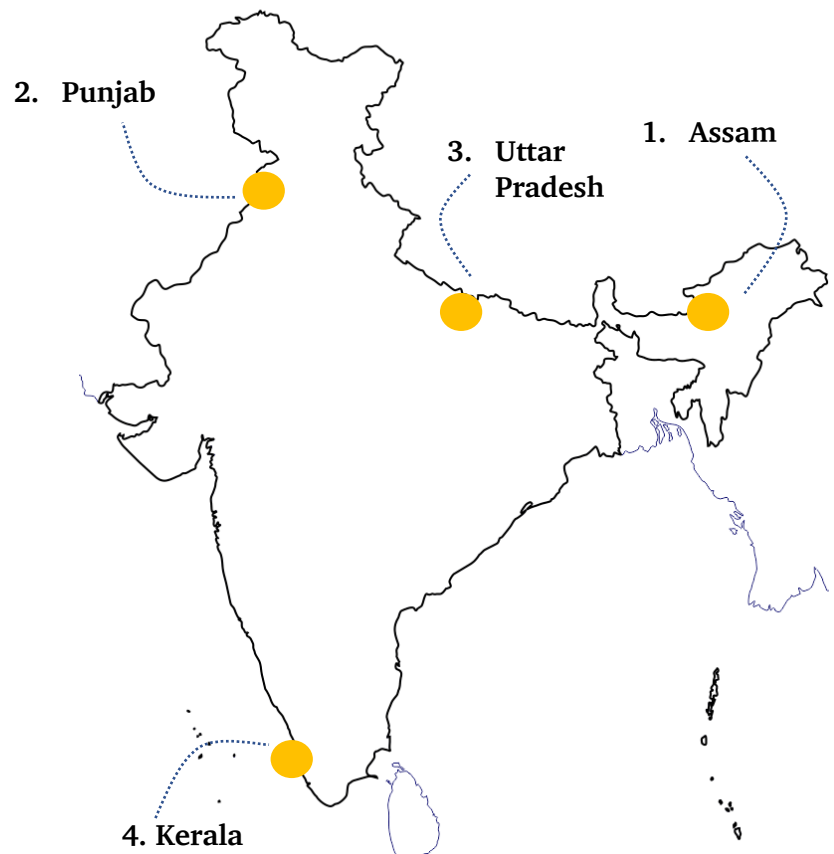

The **National Urban Digital Mission (NUDM)** is a flagship mission launched by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) in February 2021 to streamline and coordinate efforts of the urban ecosystem and to improve the ease of living for citizens by creating & strengthening a national urban digital ecosystem that delivers accessible, inclusive, efficient and citizen centric governance in India's 4800+ towns and cities. The implementation of NUDM is being anchored by the Centre for Digital Governance (CDG) under the National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA).

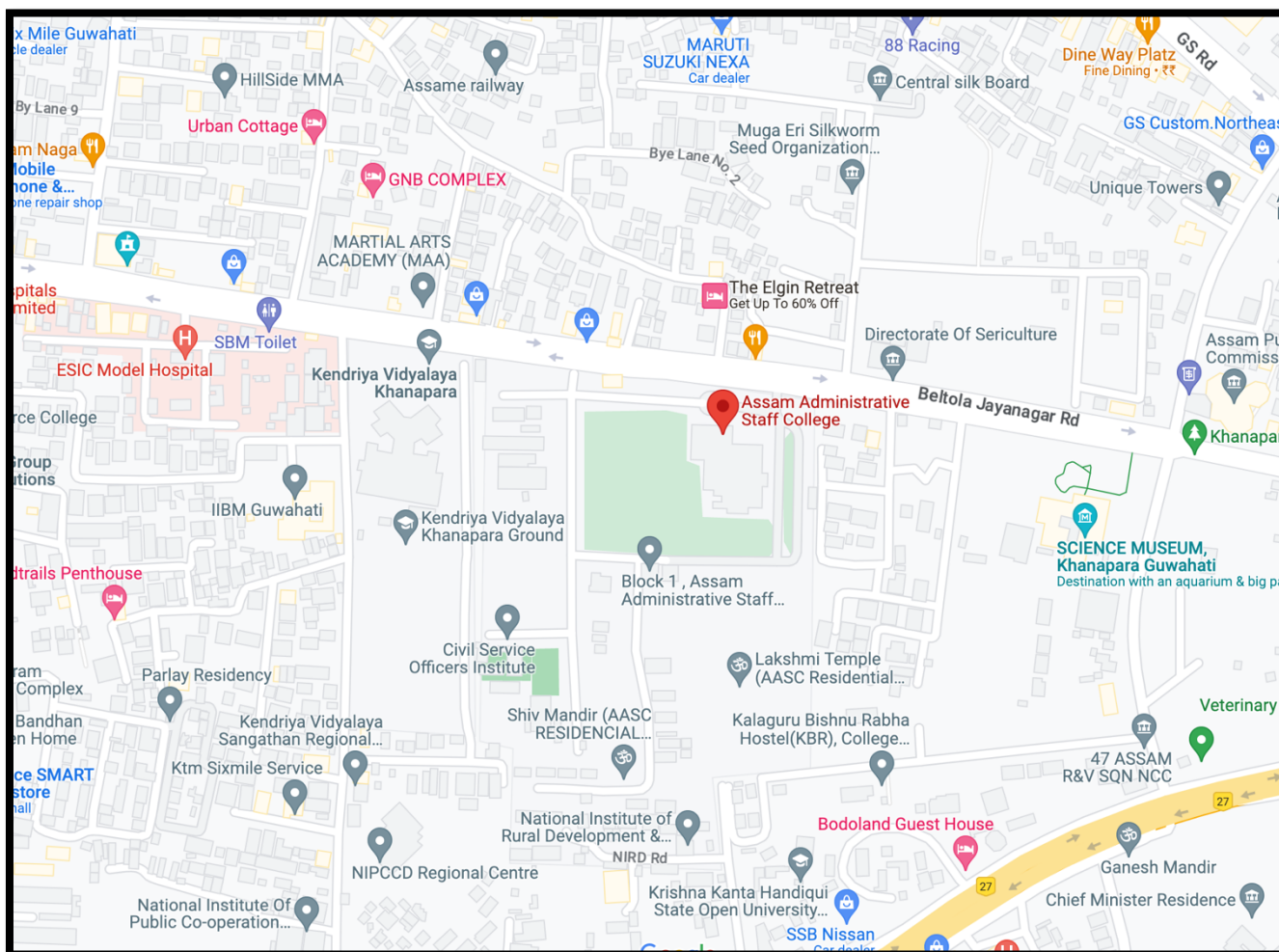
