

National Urban Digital Mission and MoHUA's Digital Initiatives Launched

Centre for Digital Governance will Anchor the National Urban Digital Mission Platforms

The National Urban Digital Mission (NUDM) was launched on 23 February by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) along with the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY). Four digital initiatives of MoHUA—India Urban Data Exchange, Smart Code, Smart Cities Website 2.0, and Geospatial Management Information System—were launched during the event. The NUDM digital initiatives will be anchored by the Centre for Digital Governance at NIUA.

The website on NUDM was launched by Shri. Hardeep Singh Puri, MoS (I/C), HUA. He highlighted that the digital platform will empower the urban local bodies to deliver services to all the citizens in a timely and efficient manner.

Shri. Ravi Shankar Prasad, Minister, Electronics & IT highlighted that the goal of Digital India can be achieved through a technology which is home grown, developmental, low-cost and inclusive.

NUDM aims to create a shared digital infrastructure that can consolidate and cross-leverage the digital initiatives of MoHUA, enabling cities and towns across India to benefit from holistic and diverse forms of support to solve complex problems at scale and speed. The mission will institutionalise a 'citizen-centric' and 'ecosystem-driven' approach to urban governance and service delivery to all cities by 2022.
