The National Real Estate Development Council (NAREDCO) organised an online consultation with the NIUA, and Delhi Development Authority (DDA) on 6 April. NIUA Director Hitesh Vaidya said the GDA (Green Development Area) and Land Pooling Policy were key ingredients for the Master Plan for Delhi-2041 (MPD41), and that it



has to come down to the neighbourhood planning level. He expressed his opinion that "whatever we do today is not for us to enjoy, it is what our next generation will cherish. The challenge is not to prepare a policy or prepare a master plan. The challenge is how to retain the faith of the young generation on our governance system.
