The National Real Estate Development Council (NAREDCO) organised an online consultation with the NIUA, and Delhi Development Authority (DDA) on 6 April. NIUA Director Hitesh Vaidya said the GDA (Green Development Area) and Land Pooling Policy were key ingredients for the Master Plan for Delhi-2041 (MPD41), and that it has to come down to the neighbourhood planning level. He expressed his opinion that *"whatever we do today is not for us to enjoy, it is what our next generation will cherish. The challenge is not to prepare a policy or prepare a master plan.
