

- Regularly monitoring the environmental cleanliness
- Assess and mitigate potential physical access barriers for vulnerable groups of people



## Infrastructure & Environment

- Invest in public transport.
- Strengthening policies that encourage more circular and efficient use of materials.
- Protect hotspot zones to restrict traffic and public flow.
- Designing quality spaces for pedestrians.
- Urban land use management processes



# Governance & Leadership

- Ensure clarity in roles, relationships and coordination mechanisms for governance.
