The United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) in partnership with the World Resources Institute (WRI), C40 Cities (C40), ICLEI-Local Governments for Sustainability (ICLEI), the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), the World Bank, and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) launched UrbanShift—a global programme working to transform cities for people and planet through integrated urban development. 


Workshop on Developing Project Design Document


