### NIUA Projects Covering Goal 1

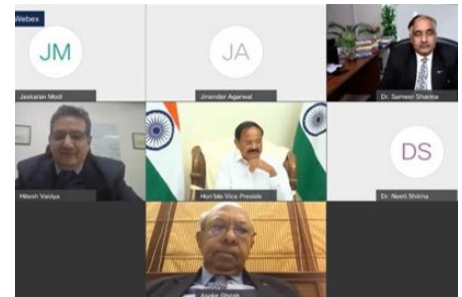
1. **Capacity Building for Low Carbon and Climate Resilient City Development in India (CAPACities):** Capacity building for mitigation and adaptation measures against climate change

A TEXTBOOK OF URBAN PLANNING AND GEOGRAPHY, a book authored by Dr. Sameer

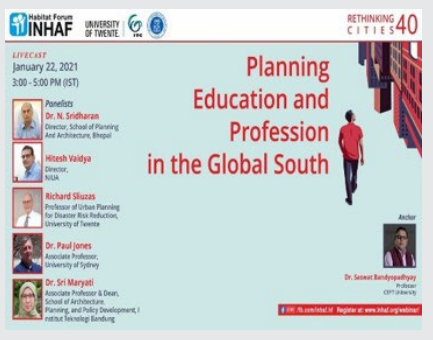

### Webinar held on Planning Education and Profession in Global South

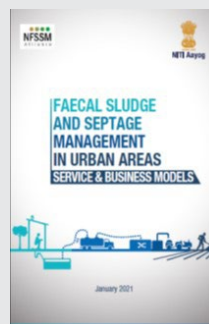
